

Working deliberately, and with open curiosity, in the holding space between freedom and constraint, artist Jo Lane creates work that incorporates found materials, drawing and a guiding sense of universal poetry. Her sculptures contrast solid, selected materiality with an air of softness and intelligence, while her drawings reflect a dedicated practice, where mind and matter are intertwined. Tactile by nature - marked, arranged and negotiated by hand from raw materials, Jo's work embraces notions of tension and release, engaging our awareness of the physical/spatia and emotional in equal measure. The viewer is invited to consider and reflect on the nature of the work itself, allowing questions to emerge and grow over time, an empathetic and cathartic response to their deeply human qualities.















UNTITLE, 2021
